



ODRPC COVID-19 Medical Scening Procedures Current as of 13-June-2020



As a minimum, the medical screening must include the following questions:

Do you have, or have you had in the past 6 days, any of the following symptoms?

Fever over 100.4° F (38° C)

Unexplained coughing

Shortness of Breath

Do you have, or have you had in the past 3 days, two or more of the following symptoms?

Loss of Taste or Smell

Headache

Nausea

Sore Throat

Chills

Muscle Aches

Shivering

Within the past 2 weeks, have you been in contact (within 6 feet for 5 minutes or more) with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19?

If possible, temperature should be taken. Use only a non-contact thermometer.

Anyone who answers YES to any of the questions or whose temperature reads 100.4° F (38° C) or higher may not be admitted.

Be sure that everyone is informed ahead of time that there will be a screening, and that they will not be admitted if they have symptoms or have been in contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 2 weeks. It is recommended that full refunds be offered for anyone who signs up but develops symptoms or is in contact with someone who tests positive.

The person conducting the medical screening and the person being screened must wear a mask, covering both nose and mouth, during the screening.
