Participants: All C level members are encouraged to apply but priority will be given to participants rated C2 or higher and at least 13 years old as of January 1, 2020. The clinic will be open all ODR zones with preference given to zone 3 members. **Registrations are accepted on a first come, first served basis**. Those accepted into the clinic will be notified shortly after the clinic closing date. *All clinic participants under the age of 18 must have a responsible adult with them at the clinic site.*

***Old Dominion Region members desiring to take (or apply for) a National level certification(s) are expected to attend at least one regional test preparation clinic specific for the certification sought by the candidate within one calendar year of the test for which the candidate applied. If the member is unable to attend an official regional prep, they must contact the RS for approval and submit in writing a plan to obtain an equivalent evaluation.

<u>Clinic Fee</u>: Discounted early registration fee is \$100.00 if submitted with proper paperwork and payment by July 16, 2020. After this date the fees will be \$125.00. Make checks payable to ODRPC and mail with registration to Karen Childers, 1425 Red Hawk Run, Christiansburg, VA 24073

Refund: Refunds will be available with a doctor or vet note only, minus a \$50 administration fee.

<u>Phases to be Covered</u>: Gridwork/stadium jumping, snd XC will be covered at this clinic. Tentative start time is 9:00 am Sunday, July 26. Your mount must be appropriate for the level, and you must be willing to share your horse for switch rides.

<u>Stabling</u>: This is a one day clinic, but if you are coming from a distance and need stabling some is available and can be arranged by contacting Sandy River Equestrian Center at 276-650-1433. Current, negative Coggins must be submitted with entry paper work.

Lodging: If lodging is needed there are hotels about 20 minutes away in Danville, VA, Contact me if you need help with this or Sandy River can make a recommendation.

<u>Meals</u>: Due to Covid we are asking everyone to bring their own food and drink and maybe something to share with the examiner. Seems the safest way at this time.

Things to Bring: Water for your horse, appropriate tops (with sleeves and collar), an ASTM-SEI helmet and XC vest. Correct footwear must be worn at all times. USPC/USEA approved medical bands must be worn at all times.
